TeamKid Overview

Since 1996, the 1st G CFD TeamKid Summer Camp has offered high quality out of school summertime programming for students in Metro Louisville and has become one of the most successful camps in the area. For the 3rd consecutive year, we have had more than 50 registered campers.

This year, the camp ran from June 5 - July 28.

BackPack League Partnership

TeamKid has, once again, partnered with Evolve502 and JCPS, also known as the BackPack League, to offer FREE summer learning and enrichment opportunities to children from ages 5 through 14. We averaged a daily attendance of 70 students.

BackPack League dates were June 21st - July 14th.

Many TeamKid campers also participated in the BackPack League, except for students beginning in kindergarten or attending non-JCPS schools for the upcoming school year.

In the morning, 2nd – 9th grade students adhere to a rotation schedule where they continue their learning from the school year in Reading, Math, STEM, and Social Emotional activities.



Kindergarten and 1st grade students spend the morning with Mrs. Trice learning the alphabet, counting, and writing.



After lunch, students participate in enrichment activities, including basketball clinics, dance, acting, robotics, therapeutic discussions, and engaging and truthful conversations about OUR HISTORY! Students also engage in organized activities in the gym and swim weekly at Sun Valley.



We keep campers active and intrigued with field trips outside of the facility. These outings include bowling, roller skating, trampoline parks, and the zoo. They also participate in outdoor activities such as hiking, fishing, canoeing, and archery.



FINAL FIELD TRIP! The end of TeamKid Summer Camp always culminates in an awesome field trip. This year, we went on an overnight trip to Cincinnati to stargaze in a planetarium, use their wits to break free from escape rooms, swim and play in a water park, and enjoy a full day at Kings Island.





We extend a warm welcome to all of our new members. We want you to know that you belong here and that we are delighted that you have chosen to come grow with us.


As a church family, we are committed to helping each other grow in our faith and deepen our relationship with God. We believe that a vital part of this journey is connecting with other believers and sharing life together.

Special Note regarding Death: Once contact has been made with either the church office or the C.A.R.E. Team, The Pastor/Executive Assistant to the Pastor will respond to each bereaved family with a call to extend condolences, offer prayer, and to schedule a time for a bereavement meeting.

*It is important that before the bereaved family goes to make arrangements with the funeral home, they make sure that the date and time is available via the Executive Assistant to the Pastor.


